

**St. Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church
Krotz Springs, LA**

Cemetery Policies

1. Row 5a is to be the first row to be developed, thereafter followed by the development of Row 5d. The remaining rows are to be developed in the order and at the discretion of Management.
2. Plots shall be sold only in successive order in each row as designated by Management.
3. A plot size is defined as five (5') feet by nine (9') feet.
4. No more than one (1) body or the remains (including cremated remains) of one (1) body shall be interred in one (1) plot.
5. It is understood that a headstone marker, base and flower urn are to be purchased at the time of purchase of the plot. The price of the plot is inclusive of the cost of the headstone marker, base and flower urn.
6. All headstone markers and flower urns are to be gray granite selected by Management and all headstone markers and flower urns are to be of a uniform style, shape and size to be determined by Management. All concrete bases are to be of uniform style, shape and size as determined by Management.
7. All headstone markers and flower urns are to be affixed to a concrete base, and all concrete bases are to be set and centered at the head of each plot.
8. The inscription on the headstone marker must include and is to be limited to: a) name of the deceased b) date of birth and c) date of death. The inscription of the name and date of birth shall be done on the headstone marker at the time of purchase of the plot. The inscription of the date of death only shall be the responsibility of the authorized representative(s) of the deceased. Said inscription shall be identical to the name and date of birth inscriptions. The representative(s) of the deceased shall be responsible for contracting for the inscription of the date of death. There shall be no inscriptions of any kind on flower urns. In the case of a U.S. Veteran to be interred, the standard issue V.A. bronze plaque with gold raised lettering measuring 5 ½ x 7 ½ may be centered and attached to the gray granite headstone (allowed on plaque: name, date of birth, date of death, branch of service and rank). Installation fee is responsibility of owner.
9. Only headstone markers, bases and flower urns shall be permitted on the plots. No monuments, decorations, vases, votives, fences or any other constructions, including, but not limited to, statues and benches, shall be permitted on the plots in the above-designated rows. A single photograph cameo is allowed but must be a morally dignified image of the deceased only, but must be subject to approval by cemetery management. Cameos must be centered above engraved name of the deceased.
10. The cemetery is not responsible for and does not provide any warranties relating to the headstone markers, bases, and flower urns, nor the installation thereof. The headstone markers, bases, and flower urns, and the installation thereof shall remain the sole responsibility of the installer.
11. Cemetery management reserves the right to supplement and/or amend these restrictions at any time.
